
This year, our goal is to award 150 students with Trunk Scholarships. Your sponsorship will ensure more students begin their college careers with the supplies they need to succeed.

The Revie Sorey Trunk Scholarships are named in honor of our former Educational Services Director and Chicago Bear who launched the program 17 years ago after learning the families of many of our college-bound students were burdened by the expense of dorm room and school supplies not covered by grants and scholarships. Trunk Scholarships are an important extension of our acclaimed College Preparation & Placement Program founded by the late Silas Purnell in the 1960s. The program has now placed more than 75,000 graduating seniors in more than 400 colleges and universities throughout the United States. Ada S. McKinley has also guided graduating seniors in securing hundreds of millions of dollars in financial aid and scholarships over the last six decades, including over \$20 million in 2024.
